Camp STIX Enrollment Information - Summer 2010

Camp STIX would not be possible without the generous donations of time, money, and supplies from our STIX community. Camp is fueled by lots of volunteers who work tirelessly throughout the year and during the camp week. We are a 100% volunteer organization. Did you know it takes

- **35 medical staff** to care for our campers 24/7? We have physicians, physician assistants, nurses, nurse practitioners, pharmacists, and medical students to care for our campers.
- **15 Kitchen/DISH staff** to make and serve healthy food. We have dietitians, nutritionists, and cheerful kitchen helpers who make, measure, calculate carbs and keep campers well fed.
- **35 Program Staff**. We have a camp director, program director, counselors, and junior counselors who provide the fun activities and loving care to our campers.
- **15 Board of Directors** who work all year for camp.
- **Vendors** who provide us with tens of thousands of dollars in glucose meters, test strips, insulin, medical supplies, backpacks, and fun take home items.

If we had to pay for all the staff, and all the supplies required to run our camp, NO ONE would be able to afford camp.

This year we are implementing a **three level enrollment fee**, based on your ability to pay:

Level One.....\$250 Minimum required Camp Fee.

Level Two.....\$340 Covers **half** of the cost for one camper.

Level Three....\$680 Covers the full cost for one camper . It includes: food, Bear Paw Camp rental, supplies, arts & crafts, administrative expenses such as insurance, office supplies, and postage.
